- Tir Na Nog U6 competition giving our youngest, non-competitive dancers a chance to hit the stage and show off their dancing skills

For a \$10 entry fee, dancers at any level are welcome to enter solo or in groups for a fun chance to dance together. 100% of proceeds will go to the Food Bank to help Calgary families in need.

## **REGISTRATION & PAYMENT INFORMATION**

#### **Entry Process**

We are using the official tabulation company of the World Irish Dance Championships, <u>FeisEntry.com</u>. Dancers who were previously entered into the Casey O'Loughlin Championships or Western Canadian Oireachtas will appear in the system & only new dances will need to be added.

Registration will be open from Aug 22<sup>nd</sup> to Sept 15<sup>th</sup> and can be completed by teachers only. Registration will be capped at <u>430 dancers</u> (max. of 230 championship level dancers)

#### Late Entries

- Fees must be postmarked no later than September 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Entries received that are postmarked after this date will be charged a late fee of \$20 per dancer.
- On-the-day' registrations are permitted but will be subject to the late fee. If we have hit our registration cap of 430 – no on-the-day registrations will be permitted.
- Unpaid entries will not receive their number cards at the feis and will not be permitted to participate in the competition unless full payment is received.
- There are no refunds for no-shows or late withdrawals.

## Admissions, Program & Results

- There is a family admission fee of \$45 which includes the e-program and online results (family members of teachers are exempt from this fee).
- The e-program will be available on our website and Facebook page in advance.
- In an effort to continue to be eco-friendly, all results will be posted online at FeisResults.com following the competition.

## Combinations and Splits

Competitions may be cancelled, combined or split at the discretion of the feis committee based on entry. Details of any changes will be provided with as much notice as possible.





## **Payment Information**

The family max is \$155; max excludes family admission, specials, 'B' Championships & 2nd chance Treble Jig & Reel trophies (Sunday). Competition costs are as follows:

- \$ 7 per competitor for solo dances
- \$15 per competitor for Beg/Adv Beginner & Nov/Prizewinner Trophy competitions (2nd chance Sunday trophies excluded from family max)

#### Championship Competitions

- \$ 50 per competitor 'A' Championships Sunday (included in family max)
- \$ 50 per competitor 'B' Championships Saturday (excluded from family max)

#### Figures Competitions

\$ 5 per competitor per competition

#### Special Competitions (excluded from family max)

- \$15 per special for Slip Jig, Treble Reel & Traditional Set Specials

Please be aware that the Casey O'Loughlin Championships will adhere to any restrictions or guidelines that are in place at the time. This could require us to limit the number of spectators or take other measures required to run a safe competition. By entering, you understand that you do so at your own risk.

Should it occur that restrictions in place cause us to be unable to run the Casey O'Loughlin Championships, you will be refunded all registration costs minus payment processing fees.



### RULES OF CASEY O'LOUGHLIN CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 1. Competitions are open only to amateurs. Only students of teachers registered in good standing with the W.C.I.D.T.A., the I.D.T.A.N.A. and CLRG may compete.
- 2. Competitor's age will be determined as of January 1st of the current year.
- 3. Entry forms are to be checked and signed by the registered teacher.
- 4. Entry Fees: Family Admission Fee: \$45 Family Max \$155
  - o Solo Competitions:
    - \$ 7.00 per dance per competitor
    - \$15.00 per competitor Beginner/Adv. Beginner Trophy
    - \$15.00 per competitor Novice/Prizewinner Trophy
  - o Figures: \$5.00 per competitor per team
  - o "A" Championships: \$ 50.00 per competitor (included in family max)
  - "B" Championships: \$50.00 per competitor (excluded from family max)
  - o Specials: (excluded from family max)
    - Slip Jig Special \$15.00 per competitor
    - Treble Reel Special \$15.00 per competitor
    - Traditional Set Special: \$15.00 per competitor

- 5. Music shall be in accordance with regulation metronome speeds.
- 6. Categories:
  - o First Feis A dancer who has not previously competed in a registered feis.
  - o Beginner A dancer who has not qualified for Adv. Beginner for that dance.
  - Advanced Beginner A dancer who has received qualifying place in that particular dance in the Beginner level but has not yet qualified to move on to Novice in that particular dance.
  - Novice A dancer who has received qualifying place in that particular dance in the Advanced Beginner level but has not yet qualified to move on to Prizewinner in that particular dance.
  - o Prizewinner A dancer who has received qualifying place in that particular dance in the Novice level but has not yet qualified to advance to Preliminary Championships.
  - o First Feis Trophy (Reel, 32 bars): Open to dancers entered in their first feis. Dancers may not compete in any other Trophy competition.
  - o Beginner / Advanced Beginner Trophies Open to dancers who dance the majority of their dances in the Beg / Adv. Beginner level in solos. A dancer must advance to





Novice/Prizewinner trophy if they receive two first place trophies, or if they advance in the majority of their solo levels.

- Novice / Prizewinner Trophies (Treble Jig 32 bars, choice of two speeds) Open to dancers who dance the majority of their dances in the Novice or Prizewinner level in their solos. Also open to dancers who have previously won two first place trophies in the Beg/Adv Beginner Trophy competitions. Dancers in ALL age groups dance the Treble Jig.
- Preliminary Championships Open to dancers who have won two first place trophies in the Novice/ Prizewinner Trophy competition, and who have not previously won two first place Preliminary Championships.
- Open Championships Open to dancers who have previously won two first place Preliminary Championships.
- Note: Competitors may only dance each dance once. Competitors entered in First Feis Reel & Light Jig competition may repeat the Reel & Light Jig in Beginner.
- 7. In Figure Dancing, only 50% of a team may be moved to higher age group to complete a Figure unless special permission has been granted by the Feis Committee prior to the Feis. All Ceili dances must be performed in accordance with the official handbook.
- 8. A competition may be cancelled or moved up to the next age category if there are fewer than three entries. If there is a large entry (as per W.C.I.D.T.A .rules), the competition will be split at the discretion of the feis committee.
- 9. All Competitors must be in the hall 60 minutes before their competition is scheduled
- 10. All dancers must be in complete dance costume, including shoes, to receive any award.
- 11. Under no circumstances are the adjudicators or the musicians to be approached during the feis. The decision of the adjudicator is final.
- 12. No steel taps or bubble heels allowed. Shoes may be subject to inspection by adjudicators. Costumes must be in accordance with the I.D.T.A.N.A. and An Coimisiun guidelines.
- 13. The Calgary Ceol Agus Rince Society, Casey O'Loughlin Championships, Casey O'Loughlin Academy of Irish Dance, the W.C.I.D.T.A., Hyatt Regency Calgary and the City of Calgary or any organization affiliated with same will not be held responsible for any personal injury, property loss or damage during the event.
- 14. Protest against breach of rules will be considered if made in writing and signed by the objector. The objection must also be accompanied by a \$25 fee and reach the Feis Committee before prizes are presented. If the complaint is justified, the \$25 fee will be refunded.
- 15. All feis committees must award a minimum of 30% of competitors in Preliminary and Open Championships.





- 16. Competitors may only compete in Trophy or Championship competition, but not both. Treble Reel trophy and "Specials" do not apply.
- 17. Any form of unauthorized photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means, eg, mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, commercial film, with or without enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition. Photography is permitted on a limited basis during First Feis and Beginner categories ONLY. No video equipment will be allowed in the hall. This is a Commission rule.
- 18. Dancers will be required to dance two steps (32 bars) only in the regular Solo and Trophy competitions but will be required to perform the mandatory number of bars in Preliminary and Open Championships i.e. 48 bars in the Reel and Treble Jig and 40 bars in the Slip Jig and Hornpipe.
- 19. Notwithstanding any other conditions specified herein, the Feis Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and to alter or cancel any rule or condition as it may be deemed necessary in the best interest of the Feis. All teachers will be advised. The Feis reserves the right to reject any entry for cause, to cancel all or part of the Feis and to limit competitor's performing time. The decision of the Feis Committee is final in all matters connected with the Feis.
- 20. Dancers shall advance in each individual solo dances as follows:

# of Dancers in Competition	Placings that advance
<5 Dancers	No placing advances
5 - 9 dancers	1st place moves up
10 - 19 dancers	1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> & 3 <sup>rd</sup> move up
20 – 29 dancers	$1^{st}$ , $2^{nd}$ , $3^{rd}$ & $4^{th}$ move up
30 or more dancers	1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 3 <sup>rd</sup> , 4 <sup>th</sup> & 5 <sup>th</sup> move up

- 21. Should a dancer win a Preliminary Championship competition that qualifies them to move to Open, no refund will be offered for the second Preliminary Championship (if registered). However the dancer may substitute the second entry credit for an entry in an Open Championship which is upcoming in the schedule.
- 22. All other Feis rules as per the An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha, the I.D.T.A.N.A. and the W.C.I.D.T.A.
- 23. By entering the Casey O'Loughlin Championships, dancers, teachers, and all spectators agree to be respectful and polite to all volunteers, competitors and their families. Disrespectful and abusive behaviour will absolutely not be tolerated. The Feis committee reserves the right to remove anyone from the event at their discretion.

## **CHAMPIONSHIPS**

Option B – In lieu of solos, individual awards will be given for each dance.

Both Championships 'A' & 'B' will be danced in full costume (blackout can be worn individually as needed)

- Hard Shoe Round: Dancers are required to dance 48 bars of Treble Jig or 40 bars of Hornpipe
- Soft Shoe Round: Dancers are required to dance 48 bars of Reel or 40 bars of Slip Jig
- Set Round: Dancers are required to dance contemporary Set Dance; U8 & U9 dancers will dance Traditional Set Dances
